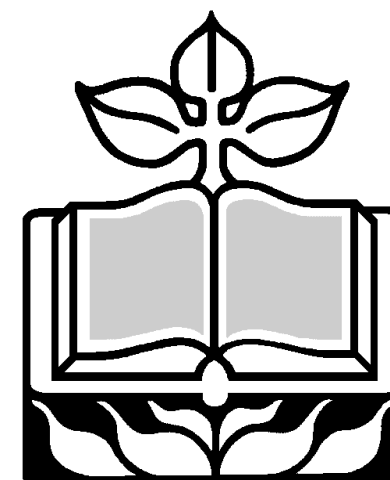
CAR PARKING is available at the rear of the
